L: The 13th Station: Jesus is placed in Mary's arms



L: We adore You, O Christ and we praise You,

R: for by Your holy Cross You have redeemed the world.

L: Mary stands by the Cross, offering her Son's sacrifice with Him. She never leaves Him for a moment, and, as He is taken down, she holds Him in her arms. (pause)

R: Mother, as you see your Son Lying cold and still, Ask for me the grace to be Faithful to God's will.

L: The 14th Station: Jesus is buried.




L: We adore You, O Christ and we praise You,

R: for by Your holy Cross You have redeemed the world.

L: Jesus' friends take His body and place it in a tomb. To them, it seemed like the end. But Mary knew that He was faithful to His promises. He would rise again so that we could be with Him forever.

R: Jesus, You were laid to rest,
Truly, You were dead.
But You rose on Easter day,
Just as You had said.
Jesus, I love you! Thank you for loving me first!

R: In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen.

L: The 1st Station: Pilate condemns Jesus



L: We adore You, O Christ and we praise You,

R: for by Your holy Cross You have redeemed the world.

L: Pilate punishes Jesus, even though Jesus has not done anything wrong. Jesus accepts this, and offers it up for us. How do I respond when I am accused of doing something wrong? (pause)

R: You have been condemned to death, Jesus Christ, my Lord! You will offer up Your life of Your own accord.



L: The 2nd Station: Jesus takes up His Cross



L: We adore You, O Christ and we praise You,

R: for by Your holy Cross You have redeemed the world.

L: After whipping Him, the soldiers give His cross. He lovingly takes it in His arms and carries it on His shoulder. He knows He carries it for you and for me. (pause)

R:Lord, You take the heavy cross which should be my own so that I never have to carry it alone.

L: The 11th Station: Jesus is nailed to the Cross



L: We adore You, O Christ and we praise You,

R: for by Your holy Cross You have redeemed the world.

L: The soldiers are ready. Jesus lies down on the Cross and spreads His arms wide. They nail His hands and feet to the Cross, and then raise it high. (pause.)

R: Jesus, You loved everyone, You forgave them all. Even those who held the nails And made the hammer fall.





L: We adore You, O Christ and we praise You,

R: for by Your holy Cross You have redeemed the world.

L: Jesus sees many people from the Cross—the soldiers, the religious leaders, His Mother and friends, and you and me. He offers Himself to the Father for each of us, and then bows His head and dies. (pause and kneel.)

R: Jesus, dying on the cross, What else could You give? You have done Your Father's will. Teach me so to live!



L: The 9th Station: Jesus falls the third time



L: We adore You, 0 Christ and we praise You,

R: for by Your holy Cross You have redeemed the world.

L: Jesus is very tired. He stumbles and falls again as He climbs the hill to Calvary. Each step feels like He can't go on, and yet He always takes one more step for us, to save us. (*pause)*

R: Jesus, falling once again **Teach me Your obedience** To the Father's will. On the rocky hill,



L: The 10th Station: Jesus is stripped of His clothes



L: We adore You, 0 Christ and we praise You,

R: for by Your holy Cross You have redeemed the world

L: The soldiers take away Jesus' clothes. They split them up among themselves to keep. Jesus allows them to take His things without arguing. He only thinks about our salvation. *(pause)*

R: As Your clothes are stripped away, You endure all this for me, You focus on one thing: You, my God and King.

L: The 3rd Station: Jesus falls the first time.




L: We adore You, O Christ and we praise You,

R: for by Your holy Cross You have redeemed the world. L: Jesus tries hard to carry His cross, but He is weak from having been beaten. He falls under its weight and then tries to rise and carry on the work of our salvation.

R:: Dearest Jesus, help me now, Make me understand that sin caused this pain to You. As You always do.



L: The 4th Station: Jesus meets His Mother



R: for by Your holy Cross You have redeemed the world. L: Mary meets Jesus on the way. She is so sad to see Jesus hurt and rejected, but she encourages Him to carry on the work of salvation. (pause)

R: Mary, as you watch your Son Help me now to promise Him Suffering for men, Not to sin again.



L: The 5th Station: Simon helps Jesus



L: We adore You, O Christ and we praise You,
R: for by Your holy Cross You

R: for by Your holy Cross You have redeemed the world.

L: The soldiers want Jesus to move faster, and so they make Simon help him. Simon was able to help Jesus! Wouldn't we all want to be near Jesus and help Him, like Simon did? (pause)

R: To help you Lord, like Simon, love will be my key.

In others' needs I find You. Grant me eyes to see!

L: The 6th Station: Veronica wipes the face of Jesus



L: We adore You, 0 Christ and we praise You,

R: for by Your holy Cross You have redeemed the world.

L: Veronica sees the blood and sweat on Jesus' face, and her heart is moved. She takes her veil and wipes His face. How can you show Jesus love, like Veronica? Who needs your kindness?

R: Jesus, how I'd like to be your brave and loyal friend, one who wipes Your holy face, and comforts you again.

L: The 7th Station: Jesus falls the second time



L: We adore You, O Christ and we praise You,

R: for by Your holy Cross You have redeemed the world.

L: Jesus falls again beneath the weight of the Cross. Even with Simon's help, the work of our salvation is so hard! He rises and continues, bearing the weight of our sins on his shoulders.

R: Down again my Savior falls on the cutting stone. You would go through all this pain For my sins alone!



L: The 8th Station: Jesus comforts the women.



L: We adore You, O Christ and we praise You,

R: for by Your holy Cross You have redeemed the world.

L: Some women come to Jesus. They are sad about what is happening to Him. He comforts them, paying attention to their needs, not His own. (pause)

R: Jesus, comforting Your friends, Yourself, without relief, Teach me to show all Your love when my heart is torn by grief.
